

EUROPEAN COMPETENCE ANALYSIS

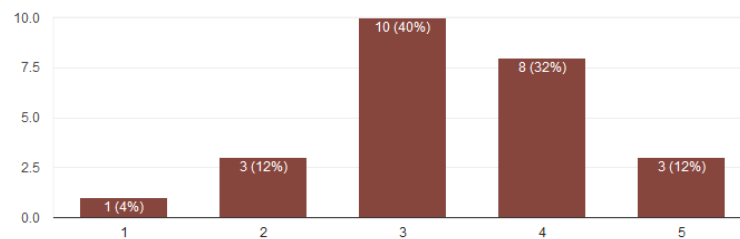
According to Polish students, their knowledge of the partner countries is at medium level. They are slightly better at the geography of these countries than at history.

They find the project rather important.

40% of the respondents claim to be able to communicate with the project friends at satisfactory level and only 12% can do it at very good level. It turns out that they prefer face to face communication, along with Facebook.

I can communicate in English with my friends from the partners countries

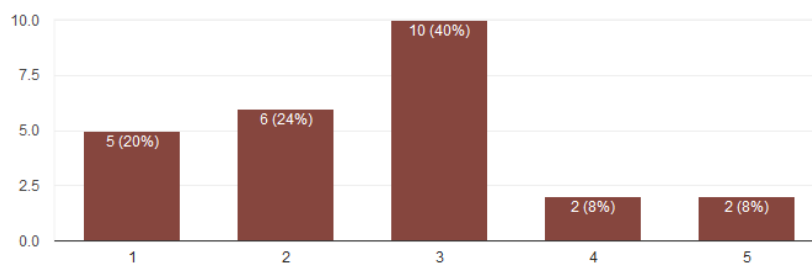

I can say and use basic phrases in partners languages (not English)

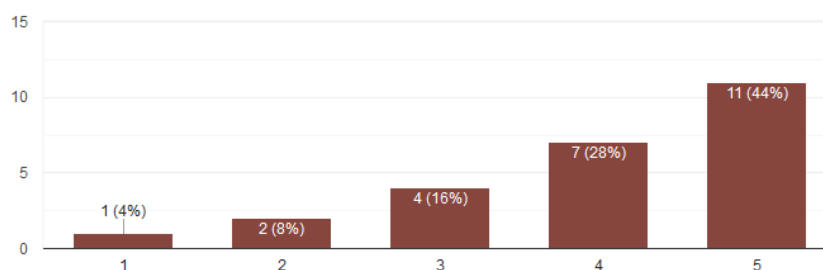

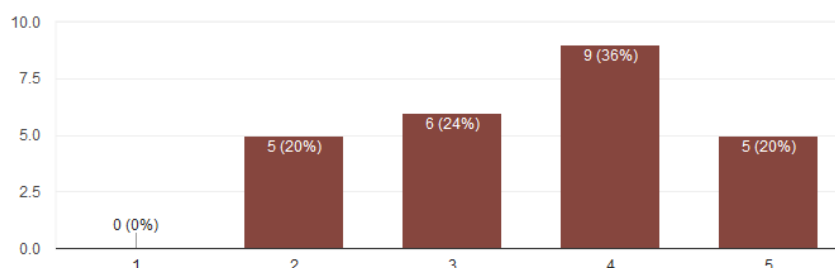
I can show respect for the different culture, traditions and background.
