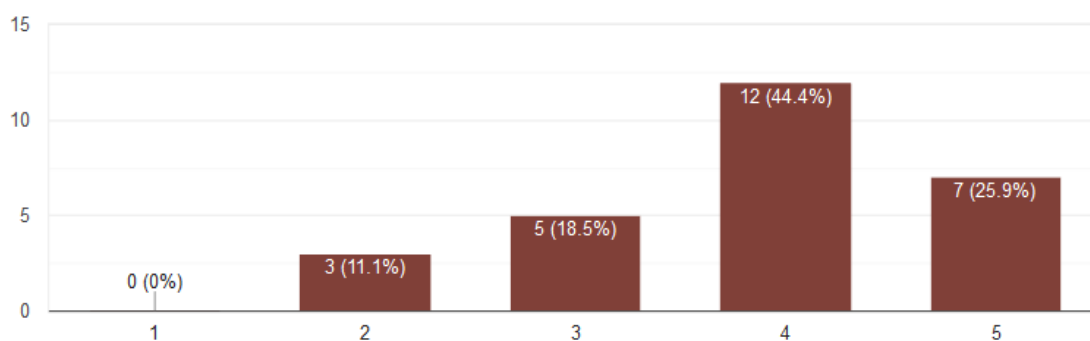


EUROPEAN COMPETENCE ANALYSIS – SECOND SURVEY

The second survey concerning European competence was presented to 27 students. According to their answers, their knowledge of the partner countries is at better level compared to the 1st survey. They feel still slightly better at the geography of these countries than at history but now they seem to know more about the traditions of the partner countries than last year. The respondents find the project very important when it comes to international friendships and relations. The majority of them claim to be able to communicate with the project friends at good or very good level.

I can communicate in English with my friends from the partners countries

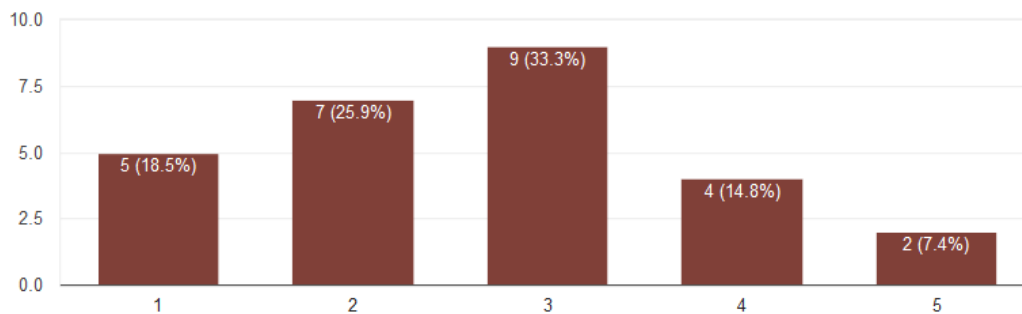

Polish students do not know many expressions in partner languages, but there has been a slight improvement. 6 students claim they do not have problems with such communication and 9 respondents indicated the satisfactory knowledge of basic foreign phrases.

I can say and use basic phrases in partners languages (not English)

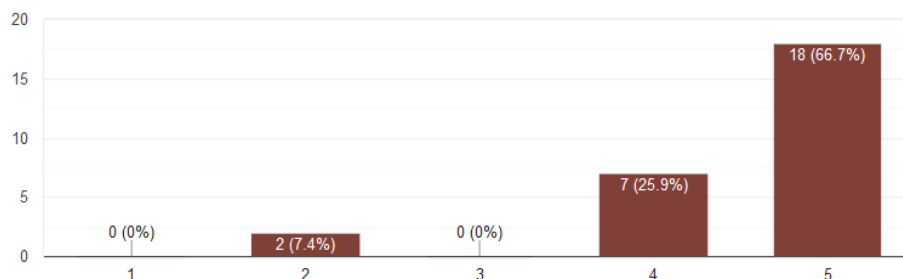

Almost all the respondents have the awareness of different norms and values existing in partner countries and they can show respect towards foreign traditions and cultures.

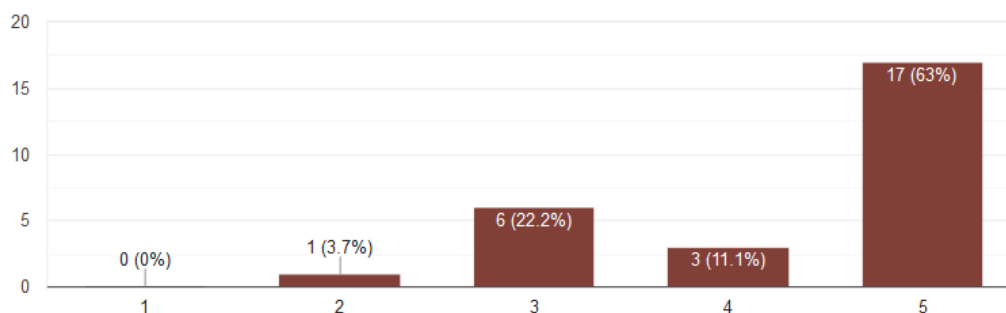
I can show respect for the different culture, traditions and background.

As a result, pupils are more aware of the differences and they can show respect towards the various norms and traditions.
