


ENGLISH LANGUAGE COMPETENCE SURVEY II

The second survey was submitted to 26 students. 17 of them have been studying English for 4-7 years, whereas 9 students have been learning it for more than 7 years. In the question about having language certificates, altogether 7 respondents gave the positive answer, which shows a slight increase in comparison to the first survey.




As far as the students' skills at English are concerned, 35 % of the respondents learning English for less than 7 years, answered that they can "ask and answer simple questions and use simple phrases and sentences", while the rest of the respondents are more advanced at other language skills. Almost half of the students can communicate well on the telephone.





As far as the group studying English for more than 7 years is concerned, all the students claimed to have higher level language communication skills.



To sum up the survey results, it can be concluded that students are becoming slightly more interested in obtaining language certificates. While in the first survey only 3 respondents had some certificates, this time 7 students claimed to own ones. In Poland, at the age of 15 all students are obliged to take the English language exam, which is one of the three obligatory national exams. Therefore, they may not feel the need to take extra tests or exams. It can also be noticed that students are becoming more confident both at speaking and virtual communication and through the project participation we will keep encouraging and motivating the pupils to raise their skills at English.
