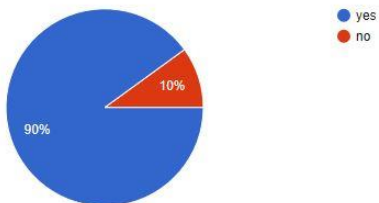

Music Competence 1st survey 2018

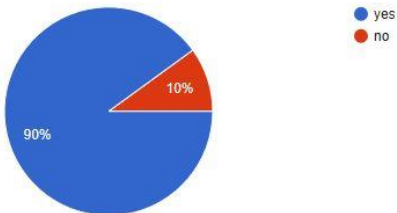
The first survey has been submitted by **20 students** involved in the project. Some of them are players, some are singers and some others are in the project without a specific musical competence.

The result is the following:

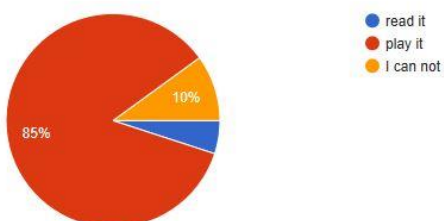
Students who play an instrument: 90%



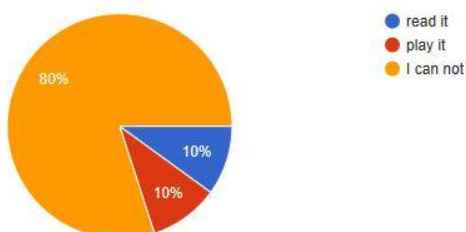
Students who cannot play easy score: 10%



Can not read or play medium difficulty score
15%



Students who cannot play a more difficult
score: 80%

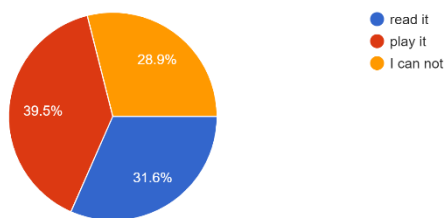


We have considered that we would reach the objective to increase the number of students who study music and improve the musical competence so we expect that

1. Increase up to 92% the students who study an instrument
2. Decrease the students who can not read or play music.

Second year measurement (2019)

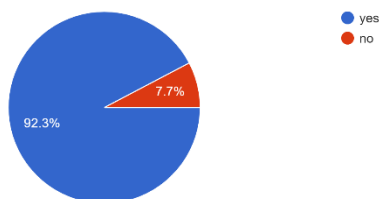
39 students answered to the questionnaire because for the mobility in <Italy more students were involved.



This refers to students who can read or play music. The percentage of the students who still can not do it , decreases from 80% to 28,9 %. We have to consider that after the first concert in Poland but mainly after the mobility in Italy, several

students started to study music with a different approach at school . Other families decided to enroll their children in private music schools.

The second aim has been reached because the result was more than 92%

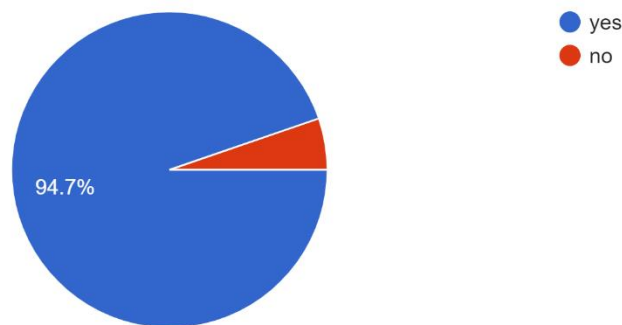
Final measurement (2021)

19 students answered to the questionnaire

This refers to students who can play an instrument. The percentage of the students who don't play any instrument, decreases from 7,7 to 5,3 %.

Do you play any instrument?

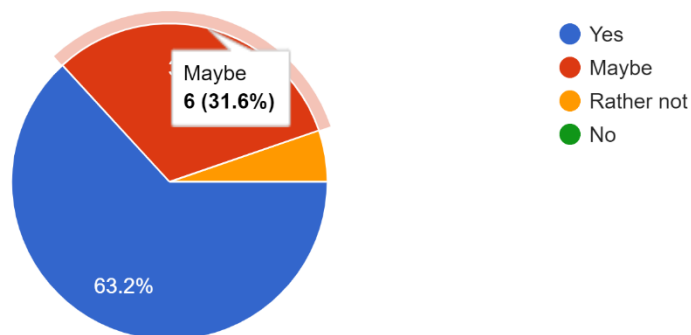
